WHAT TO BRING AND WHAT TO FORGET

Southwest Bible Camp 2021

What to Bring

- A good attitude
- A desire to learn what the Bible has for you
- A willingness to respect the leadership for the camp: the director, the speakers, the counselors
- Readiness to participate in the activities of the group
- An attitude of respect for members of the opposite sex

What to Forget

- An attitude of rebellion against authority and an attitude of wanting to "do your own thing"
- Offensive clothing & potential harmful or distractive articles, such as offensive t-shirts, halter or spaghetti tops, shorter than mid-thigh shorts, tight shorts, spandex, short skirts, immodest clothing of any kind, cut-off t-shirts, see-through or fish net blouses or shirts, ostentatious jewelry, heavy make-up, cell phones (may be kept by staff until the end of camp if necessary), electronic games or electronic entertainment, tobacco products, controlled substances (except by medical prescription,) weapons (including knives,) fireworks, pets, playing cards, motorcycles, valuables.

If You Feel

If you feel that these requests are too restrictive, then we must ask you to not come to Southwest Bible Camp; you will not benefit yourself and you will prevent other from enjoying their time at camp. A persistent attitude of defiance or willful disregard for the rules shall be grounds sending you home before camp is over at your own expense.

Camp Rules for Safety and Well-Being

(These are the general camp rules and apply to DLT week as well.)

1. Camp participants must remain on camp property. Town is absolutely OFF-LIMITS!
2. Your counselor/HLT team-leader or the HLT Director must know where you are at ALL TIMES.
3. HLT staff (& any other junior staff members) are generally bound by the same rules as campers, such as prompt attendance at all meetings – except when specific tasks require otherwise.
4. Dorms are off-limits to members of the opposite sex.
5. Wear shoes (not flip-flops or sandals) at all times while outside. (Exception: Flip-flops may be worn to & from the pool.) Pool requires females to wear t-shirt/shorts over suit and males wear t-shirt also.
6. See the camp nurse for any medical problem.
7. Regular sick call is before breakfast and before supper. Emergency help available anytime.
8. First talk over problems with your counselor/HLT team leader.
9. Bring any grievances you think are not resolved to the camp/HLT director.
10. The camp speaker is available at all times for discussion and help.
11. The camp kitchen is off limits to campers and pre-campers; (HLT youth are allowed in the kitchen for staff training & for assigned jobs.)
12. Do not leave the group. The river can be dangerous and so can things that live long its banks.
13. Swimming without official supervision is strictly prohibited. Swimmers must observe attire restrictions.
14. No motorized vehicles shall be operated by campers or HLT/junior staff while camp is in session, except for official camp business expressly authorized by the camp/HLT Director. Ignition keys must be submitted to the camp director for safekeeping. They will be returned to you when you go home.
15. No fireworks – not even on the fourth of July. Even when not in use, fireworks pose a fire & safety hazard. Any fireworks or other prohibited articles in your possession shall be surrendered to the camp/HLT Director for safekeeping. They will be returned to you when you go home.
16. Vehicle owners: keys may be kept for safe keeping and should not be operated or accessed without permission during camp sessions. Cell phones are permitted but may be restricted for use.
